

## Parish Shares for 2019

Cookhill £18,973 (14% increase) Dormston £4,862 (10.4% increase)  
 Inkberrow £37,560 (15% increase) Kington £4,353 (27.7% increase)

All of the Benefice parish shares have been reviewed and these are the revised (improved) figures following our discussions with the diocese. Obviously these are still considerable increases for all of our parishes but they are payable. Although our Benefice paid 100% of its parish share this is not the case across the diocese, where only 76% has been collected leaving a shortfall of ca. £1,000,000. I can also report that the diocese is working very hard on the its 2019 requirements as well as its 2020 Budget. At a recent emergency Bishop's Council meeting Robin and I both came away feeling quite relieved that the diocese has recognised the immediacy as well as the importance of reviewing the total diocesan requirements. There will be much paring at diocesan level as well a real effort to get those parishes who won't pay to indeed make their contributions.

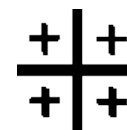
