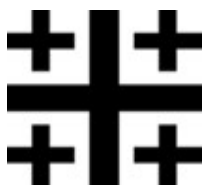

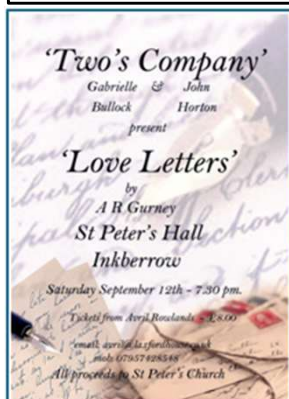
• PRAYER FOCUS:
