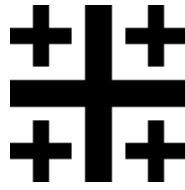

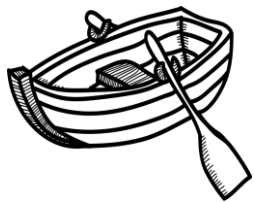

Reflection for the week from Rev'd Bruce Rienstra

On Sunday our Gospel reading referred to what it means to forgive. We find the answer on Monday, the day we celebrate Holy Cross Day. Christ demonstrated how far we should forgive. On Sunday the reading quotes Jesus saying "Not seven times, but, I tell you, seventy-seven times". The empty cross we celebrate on Monday celebrates Christ's sacrifice for our sins. An ultimate forgiveness for everyone who seeks it.

The Collect for Monday: *Almighty God, who in the passion of your blessed Son made an instrument of painful death to be for us the means of life and peace: grant us so to glory in the cross of Christ that we may gladly suffer for his sake; who is alive and reigns with you, in the unity of the Holy Spirit, one God, now and for ever. Amen*
